Conditional Acceptance to Final Acceptance

Cooperative Research and Development Agreement (CRADA)

Pre-Demonstration Requirements



Cooperative Research and Development Agreement (CRADA)

- Agreement between each System Provider (Collaborator) and DHS S&T (Sponsor)
 - Defines the roles and contributions of the Collaborator and Sponsor
 - Defines strict policy on the proper transfer and handling of 2020 Privacy
 Technology Demonstration data
 - Provides the basis for involvement in 2020 Privacy Technology Demonstration activities
 - Exempt from FOIA process
- Must be signed by Corporate Officer
- Signed copy due back to peoplescreening@hq.dhs.gov by September 2, 2020



Pre-Demonstration Requirements

- You will need to demonstrate your system's functionality using a standard video.
 - A 3-4 minute video will be provided to you by email for processing, using the conditionally accepted system.
 - This video will only be accessible on June 30, 2020 for a 2 hour window (time TBD). During this time, you will need to process this video with your privacy system.
 - The resulting obscured video output of your system must be sent to peoplescreening@hq.dhs.gov and techdemo@mdtf.org before the 2 hour deadline has elapsed.

Overall Schedule

- The 2020 Biometric Technology Rally will take place over a three-week period from September 28 October 18, 2020.
- Following the completion of the 2020 Rally, assessment of the Privacy Technology Demo systems will begin.
- Timeline
 - Pre-Privacy Demonstration Video Processing Qualification June 30
 - System Delivery to the MdTF October 2
 - 2020 Rally September 28 October 18
 - Privacy Technology Demonstration Assessments October 18 January 18



Installation Logistics

- Delivery and Installation
 - You will need to provide your privacy system to perform the required processing on-location at the MdTF.
 - If your privacy system requires more than the specifications below, you will need to provide your own hardware/computing resources:
 - Memory: 32 GB
 - CPU: Intel Xeon Silver 4116 (12 cores)
 - 100 GB disk space
 - Windows or Linux
 - Edge or Cloud processing not included in these specifications
- Intranet and Internet Connectivity
 - The system running your privacy algorithm will remain stand-alone and will not be connected to any network.
 - Please ensure your system does not have any "phone home" requirements to function properly.

Privacy Technology Demonstration

- The Privacy Technology assessments will be performed in the months following the 2020 Biometric Technology Rally (October 2020 – January 2021).
- Privacy systems will be installed at the Maryland Test Facility.
- Each system will be fed a collection of videos that were recorded as human volunteers traversed the Maryland Test Facility during prior test events. Possible sources of videos include:
 - Web cameras
 - Ceiling cameras
 - Security cameras
 - Body-worn cameras



Privacy Technology Demonstration

- A Maryland Test Facility staff member will be operating your Privacy System during the demonstration.
- Please provide a step-by-step SOP with the delivery of your system.
- The Privacy Technology Demonstration is occurring during the months after the 2020 Biometric Technology Rally. Please ensure your Privacy System can remain at the Maryland Test Facility for 120 days after your initial delivery.
